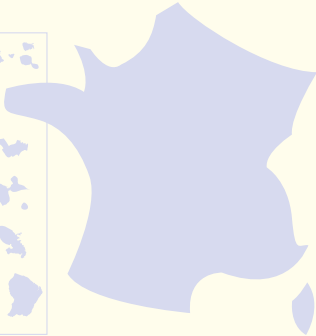

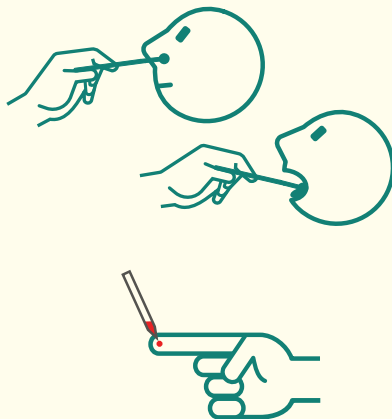

## Protect against Covid: tests in France

There exists several types of tests:

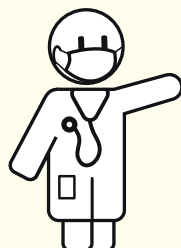


- **PCR or lateral flow detection tests** that look for the presence of the virus. Sample taken from the nose or from saliva.
- **Serological test** to see if you have had Covid (blood sample or drop of blood from fingertip).

Tests are performed by a professional or by yourself via an autotest.

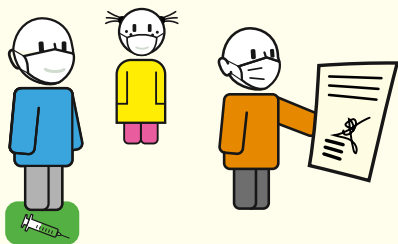
## Where to be tested?

In a chemist, by a health professional, or with a non-statutory organization.



## What is the cost of the tests?

Tests are free for:



- All children under 18.
- Vaccinated adults or those who have been in contact with Covid patient or have a medical prescription (if not, they will be charged).

Some charities give out free autotests.

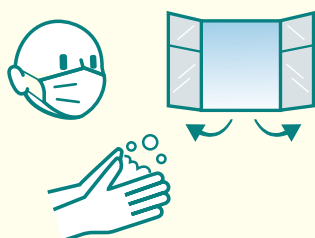


To be tested, it is **not necessary** to have a social security card or state medical aid (Aide médicale d'Etat AME).



## What to do if test is positive?

- Speak to a health professional who will monitor your health.
- Respect good hygiene measures to protect your loved-ones and if possible stay isolated from them.
